UTEBO

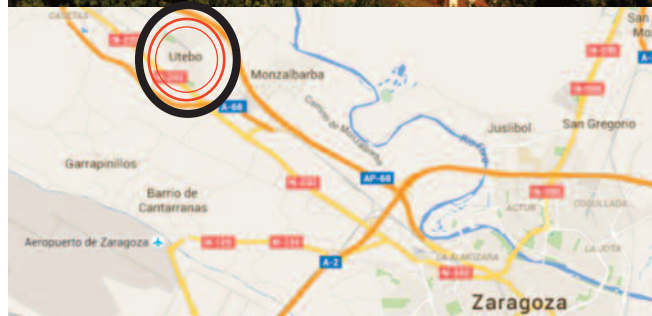

UTEBO MUST-SEE PLACES

MUDÉJAR TOWER AND NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LA ASUNCIÓN CHURCH

Plaza de España.



This beautiful historic, artistic and monumental area is one of the leading exponents for the mudéjar art in Aragon. The church, whose sanctuary end dates from 1510, was built by Anton de Saryñena and it was finished in 1521. The mudéjar sanctuary end was replaced by a baroque one which dates from 1777. It was built by Matheo Jorge Mayor and Matheo Jorge Menor, masters builders from Zaragoza, who finished its construction in 1797.

The mudéjar part of the church is divided in three stretches, with chapels between each buttress. The materials used are bricks and plaster, the typical in the aragonese mudéjar churches. The mudéjar tower, also called "Mirror Tower", was finished by Alonso de Leznes in 1544, and it has an internal structure analogous to an arab minaret.



CENTRO CULTURAL MARIANO MESONADA / ORÚS MUSEUM

The C.C. "Mariano Mesonada" is a municipal building focused on the development of culture. It contains temporary exhibitions, funds of contemporary arts, hands-on workshops and a permanent museum dedicated to the famous aragonese painter José Orús (1931-2014) work.



SCULPTURAL PATRIMONY

Utebo held an international sculpture symposium for several years. As a result, Utebo has got an incredible sculptural patrimony which can be admired all over the city in squares, parks and garden areas.



CENTRO CULTURAL EL MOLINO / INTERPRETATIVE SPACE

The Centro Cultural El Molino is a municipal building situated over the remains of the ancient mill of Utebo. This mill, that appears in the ancient street maps of Utebo, was initially used to produce flour. In the 20th century it was also used to produce hydroelectric energy thanks to the irrigation ditch of La Almozara. In the past month of april the C.C El Molino opened an interpretative space in its ground floor in which you can admire the ancient remains of the mill as well as two scale models and several information panels.
